Developing strategies for SEPLs

- Developing an strategy for managing SEPLs involves thinking through what you would need to do, with whom, when and the capacities and other resources that would be required to do it.
- The 'what' or the 'actions' in the strategy correspond with the key steps in initiating a landscape management process (see next slide for guidance)



`Actions' in a strategy ('the what')

- Define the landscape (on preliminary basis)
- Identify key stakeholders from communities and organizations in landscape
- Form a core team
- Characterize landscape issues, assets, opinion leaders
- Engage leaders and stakeholders in baseline assessment
- Adapt scoring tools to establish a baseline
- Share findings to help mobilize action
- Foster agreement on entry points and priorities for change



Implementing the Actions

- With whom? (lead person, core actors, important partners, collaborators/resource people)
- Where? (in what geographical location(s) will you focus the action)
- When? (when initiated? when completed?)
- What capacities and resources needed? (expertise, information, money)

Indicators to assess progress toward goal



Desired impacts across the landscape (on livelihoods, environment/ecosystem services, institutions & production)
