INMIP's annual Learning Exchange will bring together farmer innovators from 10 member countries in a Walking Workshop methodology for strengthening local food autonomy, biocultural heritage territories, and policy support for mountain communities.

The **objectives** of the Learning Exchange are the following:

- (1.) Capacity building for establishing Biocultural Heritage Territories and associated tools and technologies for adaptation and mitigation.
- (2.) Discussion of the draft INMIP Strategic Plan for network consolidation.
- (3.) Policy research and engagement through: (a.) Capacity building on UNFCCC policy discussions (b.) Evidence gathering on the role of biocultural heritage in climate adaptation and mitigation to inform the UNFCCC policy processes.
